

# Public Notice of Paddle Race

Hosted by the Sutherland Shire Canoe Club (SSCC) & Dolls Point Paddlers (DPP)

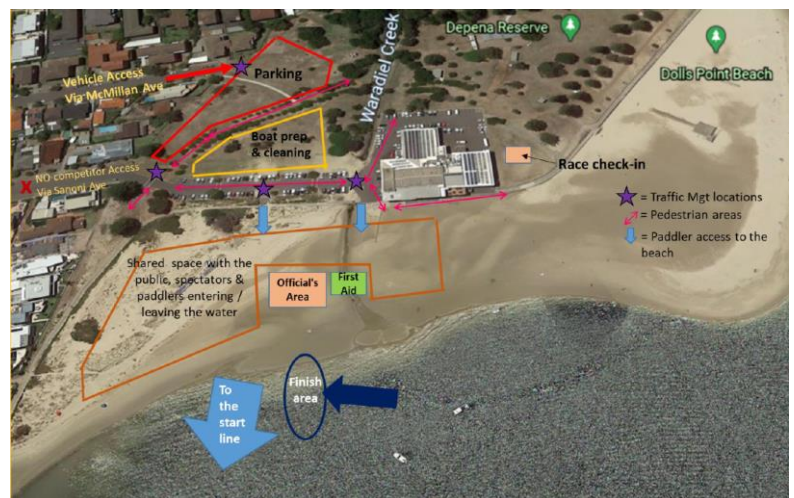
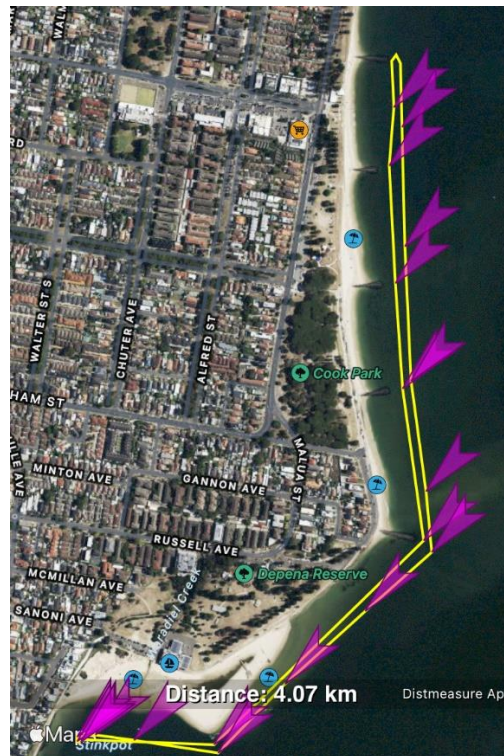
Residents and the public are invited to watch exciting kayak racing of around 70 paddlers compete on Botany Bay. The event is being conducted under an approved non-exclusive Aquatic License and Bayside Council Permit. The waterways remain open to all normal traffic.

Starting and ending at the beach in front the Georges River Sailing Club on Botany Bay competitors paddle a 4 kilometer lap course, completing as many (or as few) laps as possible within the 4 hour period.

Multiple safety vessels will be on the course. Temporary buoys will be deployed during the race to mark the course and water hazards. Race HQ will located in the Lady Robinson Beach outside the GRSC (between beach access points 14 and 15).

**The public is advised of the following impacts:**

- Fishing from the shoreline, structures and water is likely to be disrupted by race activities
- The area in Peter Depena Reserve at the end of McMillan Ave, Sandringham will be used for parking, boat preparation and cleaning and race operations
- The public should take extra care in Peter Depena Reserve and on the paths around the GRSC
- Boat operators are reminded to observe the posted maximum speed restrictions, and minimize boat wash in accordance with Maritime Safety Act 1998, part 2, section 13 - Reckless, dangerous or negligent navigation and other acts
